RULES & GENERAL INFORMATION

GENERAL RULES

GENERAL

- 1. ALL entries are to be lodged online, Please enter correctly as no fee will be refunded for incorrect entries. No accepted entry fee shall be refunded unless a section is cancelled.
- **2. Risk**, Competitors compete at their own risk. No responsibility will be taken for accidents, thefts, or lost property at this Dance Eisteddfod.
- **3. Copyright,** The Port Macquarie and District Eisteddfod Society Inc. does not accept any responsibility for any infringement of the Copyright Act. Royalty by performers or those associated with the performances. copied music and choreography is used at their own risk. We assume that all studios/schools hold the relevant licenses.
- **4. Entry,** The Committee reserves the right to refuse entry into the Eisteddfod & reserves the right to transfer a competitor to another section if they believe an error has been made. Please check you have entered the correct section.
- **5. Winning 1st place**, After submitting your entry any competitor who gains 1st place in Novice/Intermediate sections (or equivalent) at any Eisteddfod up to the closing date must notify the committee.
- **6. Music:** Files should be in MP3 format with no blank space & uploaded during the entry process, CDs or USBs will not be accepted.
- 7. Microphones, The use of microphones will not be permitted in any performance.
- **8. Photography**, The use of private video recorders, still cameras or mobile phones, with or without flash are not permitted. The committee has engaged the services of Move Media, Photography, Videography for the duration of the Eisteddfod.

All entrants must agree to Eisteddfod's Media and Photography Policy, consenting to the following conditions: Port Macquarie & District Eisteddfod society Inc and its partners may publicise the name, profile, and photograph of an entrant in event publications and results, via electronic, social, and printed media, at its discretion. No remuneration or compensation whatsoever shall be attributable to any participants featured in promotional publications or material.

9. Proof of age, The committee reserves the right to call upon any competitor at any time to provide proof of age if requested.

10. Age Limit

- Solo & Duo Trio Competitors ages to be calculated as of 1st September each year.
- Groups only: Competitors age to be calculated as of 1st January each year.

Age is determined by the eldest competitor in a Group

- 11. Glasshouse Entry, it is a fire safety requirement of the Glasshouse that everyone sign in and out of the back of house area. We ask that dance & educational schools provide their own class rolls / Sign in sheets of performers in each session of the group weekend. Failure to provide these lists means that you will not be allowed entry into the Glasshouse.
- **12. Admittance**, Competitors and audience members are not required to pay an admittance fee during the solo **sections only** of the Eisteddfod.

Tickets for Educational Schools Night and Group Weekend are to be purchased from the Glasshouse Box Office in Clarence Street or through The Glasshouse website.

Limit of 4 tickets per family for INFANTS & PRIMARY sections.

SECTIONS

13. Any Other Style, Any style of dance **not** included in this syllabus for the specific age group. Examples of dances that can be performed in this section are:

Bollywood, National Character, Mime with dance, Acrobatic dance.

14. Duos/Trios, Names, ages and entry fee for all competitors must be included in one entry. Competitors dance in the section of the eldest competitor. A competitor may only perform once in an age group/section.

One substitution will be allowed with prior approval from the PMDES Committee.

15. Allcomers Solo or Group Sections, Theses are inclusive sections open to all ages and abilities; Teachers are most welcome.

Reserved for entrants that are not competing in any other solo or group section of the Eisteddfod.

COSTUMES AND CHANGE ROOMS

- **16.** Attire, Stockings must be worn if the competitor's costume has a higher cut leg line than a boyleg for all sections of the competition. (skirts/dresses must wear stockings)
- 17. Cameras, Due to child protection reasons, no photographs are to be taken in the changing rooms.
- 18. Change Rooms, Entrants must use the dressing rooms provided (if applicable) and should not dress in hallways or foyers. No Boys/Males are allowed in the girls change room and no Girls/Females are allowed in the boys change room. This includes Teachers & Parent Helpers

STAGE

- 19. Stage Entries / Exits, we ask that all routines enter Stage Left and exit Stage Right where possible. NO part of the performance may be performed in the auditorium. Entry & exit from the stage must be via the wings only.
- 20. Side Stage, Committee, competitors & approved supervisors only backstage.

No teacher parent or friend will be permitted to view dancers side stage contact or assist competitors in anyway during the competition.

21. Supervision

- Baby Dance Solo One Supervisor is permitted Back Stage.
- 4yrs/u,6yrs/u, 8yrs/u & 10yrs/u Groups **Two Supervisors** are permitted Back Stage.
- Educational Groups Two Supervisors must be present Back Stage.

Supervisors are for supervision only no prompting or assistance of any kind once the performance has begun.

22. Support

- 4ys/u Groups Two students/teachers may perform with the group in "Stage Blacks" not a costume, these
 students/teachers will also be able to instruct the students on stage and handle the props. No prompting
 from the audience.
- Supported Learning, Allcomers
 - Support levels for backstage and during the performance can be made by prior arrangement with the committee.
- 23. Props must fit through a standard doorway, be easily carried backstage, and be used by the entrant / entrants without any assistance.
- No prop that needs assembly on site will be permitted.
- Each entrant is responsible for placing and removing props within the time limit.
- Props must be wheeled or carried, not dragged onto the stage.
- Damage to the floor by props is the sole responsibility of the entrant.
- Props cannot be stored in the venue before the session & must be removed after the session's conclusion.
- Any deliberate act which causes a prop to leave the stage may lead to disqualification.
- No stage property is to be used as a prop without the prior permission of the Dance Committee.
- **24. Safety**, Dangerous items are forbidden. No glass, naked flame, liquid, powder, glitter, or fine particles are to be used during the performance. All items used during a performance must remain on the stage. If the floor is littered during a routine, entrants must be prepared to clear the floor within the time limit.

GROUPS

25. Group / **Section**, Competitors may only compete in **ONE group in the same section**. Groups must consist of a minimum of four competitors. Sections will be included based on entries.

26. Educational School Rules

- 1. We do not accept combined School Groups.
- 2. Students may only compete in **ONE Division**, **per Section** for their School and in the grade that they currently
- 3. Small Primary School defined (0 to 230 students) NSW Government website.
- 4. Two supervisors must always be present. No prompting or assistance of any kind once the performance has begun. Supported Learning needs can be arranged with the committee

PERFORMANCE

- 27. No routine may be repeated during the Eisteddfod except for Scholarships, A slight variation of steps does not constitute a new routine.
- 28. Competitors may dance in one solo only in each style of dance.
- **29. Time Limits,** (alculated from the first step of the dance or with the start of the music to the end of the music. Bows to music are considered part of the routine and will be timed.

30. Eligibility, All sections (except Allcomers sections) are open to amateurs only. Professional dancers and teachers are not permitted to compete at the Port Macquarie and District Dance Eisteddfod.

Professional Dancer Defined: Any person who has ever been a cast member of any professional dance, TV, Musical or Theatre production with a running time of four weeks or more is considered a professional and may not compete in the Port Macquarie and District Dance Eisteddfod.

Teacher Defined: A person who is or has ever been employed to teach dance professionally.

E.g., having teaching qualifications or having been listed as teaching staff of a dance school on a full-time or parttime basis.

Student Teachers: Any student 19 years and under who teaches dance part time at the dance school or schools they currently attend are considered amateurs and as such are eligible to dance in all sections of the Port Macquarie and District Dance Eisteddfod.

31. Appropriate Language and Content, Please ensure that the content of all performances is appropriate for all audience age groups. Bad language and some adult themes are not deemed appropriate for eisteddfods. Please make yourself fully aware of the lyrics of the music being used. Inappropriate language in songs is unacceptable.

SOLOS

32. Solo Levels

- OPEN BABY DANCE, Must be 6yrs and under only and may enter only one Baby Dance.
- **NOVICE SOLOS**, Restricted to competitors who have not won first place in that style at any age at any Eisteddfod or equivalent competition.
- **INTERMEDIATE SOLOS**, Restricted to competitors who have not gained first place in that style at any age at any Eisteddfod or equivalent competition in either Open or Intermediate sections or sections of equivalent status to Intermediate / Open.
- OPEN SOLOS, Unrestricted.

Remember If you compete in Open sections at the Port Macquarie & District Eisteddfod at any age, you MUST remain in Open sections in that style for all future Port Macquarie & District Eisteddfods **unless** an intermediate section was unavailable in the competitor's age group & style at the time of entry, in this case the competitor may enter intermediate if he /she didn't win in the open section.

- **33. Dancers Own Choreography,** Dancers choose their own music and style of dance and costume to suit the dance. This must be **FULLY** students' own work.
- **34. Song & Dance**, Music for Song and Dance must be instrumental only. **No vocals spoken**, **sung or backing vocals** are permitted at any time during the routine. This applies to groups and solos.
- **35. Title,** Demi Character and National Character competitors must give the title of their piece when they enter. Description to be kept brief.
- 36. Variations, Variations from classical repertoire are permitted for Open Sections 15yrs and over Only
- **37. Improvisations**, Music is set by the Adjudicator. Competitors improvise the dance after hearing the music once only. A mark will be awarded for improvisations, but no written adjudication report will be issued, this does not apply to championships. It is the responsibility of the competitor to be inside the impro room PRIOR to the commencement of the item. Only competitors in lockdown will be permitted to compete.
- **38.** Costume Guidelines for Improvisations, Plain unadorned (no lace or sheer fabric) must be worn, maximum 2 plain colours. **No Patterns, marbling or floral allowed. No fishnet stockings.** Short skirt is optional (knee length or above). Tight shorts or jazz pants permitted.

No adornment allowed in the hair. Earrings: Plain Studs or Sleepers only. No diamante earrings. No glitter makeup or glitter eyelashes. No sequins whatsoever. No phones are permitted in the impro room.

CHAMPIONSHIPS & SCHOLARSHIPS

- **39. Championships**, All competitors must qualify in their open age solo sections and be 19 years and under to be eligible to compete in Championships. (See the Championship section for further details.)
- 40. Scholarships, are not eligible to be won in consecutive years by any competitor.
 - To be eligible for each Scholarship competitors must compete in Open Championships in the appropriate dance style.
 - Qualifying dances for Championship must be danced as per the program.
 - Competitors entering the Scholarships will be privileged to take a class by the Adjudicator, where finalists will be chosen to dance on Presentation Night.
 - Classical finalists must dance a classical solo. A maximum of 3 minutes per dance. Open only to Amateurs (see rule No. 30)
 - Award for Port Macquarie & Hastings District Boundary Competitors in all Scholarships.
 - At least one of the 1st or 2nd placegetters must reside within the Port Macquarie & Hastings District Boundary.
 - If 1st place is awarded to a competitor residing outside the Port Macquarie & Hastings District Area, then the 2nd place must go to the highest scoring competitor who does reside within the Port Macquarie & Hastings District Boundary. The Adjudicator may announce this as 2nd Place or the highest scoring local competitor.
 - If 1st place is awarded to a Port Macquarie & Hastings District competitor, then 2nd place can be awarded to any competitor regardless of place of residence.
- **41. Cash Awards**, Championships/Scholarships require a minimum of four entries. If less than 4 competitors enter into a championship/scholarship the committee reserves the right to allow the championship/ scholarship to be danced, however an Adjudicators decision may see the cash award apportioned accordingly.

BREAKDOWN

42. Breakdown, No competitor can repeat a dance after breakdown except at the request of the Adjudicator. In this case no mark or place will be awarded, adjudication only.

DISPUTES

- **43. Bad Behavior**, Any competitor who is found to be acting in an abusive or destructive manner including interfering with any other person's property or is disrespectful to the Committee, Eisteddfod volunteers, or other competitors will be reported to your Dance Teacher & may be disqualified or eliminated from further competition for that year. This rule also applies to any members of a competitor's support group (including parents and teachers). Discourtesy to other competitors will not be tolerated. Failure to comply will lead to disqualification.
- **44. Protests,** Any protest must be lodged with the session coordinator in writing immediately on completion of the section in respect of which the protest is entered and must be accompanied by \$25.00 which will be forfeited if the protest is deemed frivolous or unfounded.
- **45. Disputes**, The decision of all available dance committee members, and a minimum of 3 members, on all questions and disputes arising out of, or not provided for in these rules, shall be final. All entries are therefore deemed to be made subject to this condition and decisions of the quorum of the dance committee shall not be subject to any appeal of law as being contrary to the spirit of friendly competition upon which this Eisteddfod is based.



EDUCATIONAL SCHOOLS

Time limit is 5 minutes maximum.

SCHOOLS SECTIONS

Section 1. Infants Groups Early Stage 1 & Stage 1

- **Division 1** Only for students attending K-Year 1
- Division 2 Only for students attending Year 2

Exemption - A Kindergarten / Yr1 student may perform in division 2 if the school is unable to enter a group in division 1. Students may only compete in **ONE Division**, **per Section**

Section 2. Primary Groups: Stage 2 & 3

- Division 1, Stage 2 Only for students attending Years 3 & 4
- Division 2, Stage 2 & 3 Only for students attending Years 3 to 6
- Division 3, Stage 3 Only for students attending Years 5 & 6

Exemption - An Infant student may perform in the lowest primary division entered by their school if that school is unable to enter a group in the Infants section. Students may only compete in **ONE Division**, **per Section**

Section 3. Boys Only K - Stage 3 For boys attending K to 6

Section 4. Small Schools - Early Stage 1 - Stage 3 For students K to 6

Section 5. Supported Learning/MC For students K to 12

The committee reserves the right to combine or split any sections / divisions.

SECONDARY SCHOOLS SECTIONS

Section 6 Contemporary, Lyrical, Classical Ballet – Only for students attending Yr7 – Yr12 **Section 7 Any Other** Style – Only for students attending Yr7 – Yr12

Groups: Competitors may only compete in **ONE group in the same section**. Groups must consist of a minimum of four competitors. Sections will be included based on entries.

EDUCATIONAL SCHOOL RULES

- 1. We do not accept combined School Groups.
- 2. Students may only compete in **ONE Division**, **per Section** for their school and in the grade that they currently attend.
- 3. Small Primary School defined (0 to 230 students) NSW Government website.
- 4. Two supervisors must always be present. No prompting or assistance of any kind once the performance has begun. Supported Learning needs can be arranged with the committee.

General Rules Reminder

Props must fit through a standard doorway, be easily carried backstage, and be used by the entrant / entrants without any assistance. No prop that needs assembly on site will be permitted.

Each entrant is responsible for placing and removing props within the time limit, props must be wheeled or carried, not dragged onto the stage.

Damage to the floor by props is the sole responsibility of the entrant.

Any deliberate act which causes a prop to leave the stage may lead to disqualification.

Stage Entries / Exits, we ask that all routines enter Stage Left and exit Stage Right where possible. NO part of the performance may be performed in the auditorium. entry & exit from the stage must be via the wings only.

It is essential to remember that by entering, you agree to abide by all the rules of the Port Macquarie & District Eisteddfod Society. You are responsible for reading and understanding all rules, as ignorance will not be accepted as an excuse. Failure to comply may result in your groups not being placed.
